


Hello, We are Davinci's Dream!

The Igloo Winter Cat House Project by Da Vinci's Dream Animal Rescue is a community-driven effort to help outdoor and feral cats stay safe, warm, and dry during the winter months. Using affordable, Igloo coolers, volunteers transform them into insulated shelters that protect cats from freezing temperatures, wind, and moisture.























It's doorway time! Grab your 6-inch hole saw and make a round entrance near the front corner of the cooler. This little opening will be your kitty's front door — just the right size to slip in, curl up, and stay toasty all winter long.

Step 1: Cut a 6 Inch Hole.



Step 2: Add the Cozy Trim!













Cut an 18-inch piece of 1-inch pipe insulation and pop it around the edge of the hole. It's like adding a bumper — keeps the soft entrance smooth and helps hold in warmth. Fancy and functional!










Drill or four small holes in the bottom of the cooler for drainage. That way, if any moisture sneaks in, it can escape — no soggy paws allowed!

Step 3: Drill 4 Small Drain Holes



Step 4: Add the Straw!






















Close up the back of the cooler and tape it tightly. This locks in warmth and keeps out drafts. Your cat house is ready — a snug, safe hideaway for your outdoor friends!
